**Harris Interactive Revises Panelist List for the 2007 Harris Interactive College Football Poll**  
*Ranking teams begins on September 23*

**ROCHESTER, N.Y. – September 4, 2007** – Harris Interactive® has updated the list of 114 panelists, which includes former coaches, players, administrators and current and former media, who will rank college football teams as part of the 2007 Harris Interactive College Football Poll<sup>SM</sup>. This updated list, replacing the list released on August 28, reflects that Cedric Minter has replaced David Diaz-Infante.

For a third season the poll will be one of the components in the BCS Standings Formula used to determine the two teams that will play in the BCS National Championship game and those that qualify for at-large selection. The Bowl Championship Series formula for the 2007 season will consist of the Harris Interactive College Football Poll, the *USA Today* Coaches Poll, and an average of six computer rankings (Anderson & Hester, Richard Billingsley, Colley Matrix, Kenneth Massey, Jeff Sagarin and Peter Wolfe). The first BCS standings will be released on October 14.
